- Monday 11th May – Thursday 14th May SATs Week for Year 6 children. All children will need to be in school this week please. Thank you for your support.

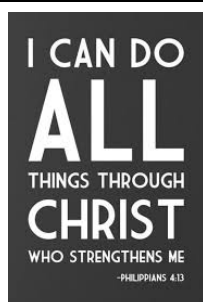
Don't Forget
