



Pupil Premium 2018 – 2019

This is funding allocated to the school and is based on the number of pupils who have been eligible for Free School Meals in the last six years, or who are looked after by the Local Authority, or have parents in the Armed Forces. The Pupil Premium money which Lea Endowed receives in our school budget is used to make a contribution to the cost of a range of intervention and support programmes. This targeted support ensures that all of our children are supported in their learning so that they can make the best possible progress. We identify areas of need for particular children through careful data analysis and discussion with staff, parents and pupils. We then plan the best intervention strategies to address those needs and track the children's progress through discussions with class teachers at half-termly Pupil Progress meetings; this enables us to measure the impact of any additional funding we receive.

- The confirmed award from the DfE is £37,520 for Pupil Premium Funding
- This is based on £1,320 per child and based on 26 children recorded as FSM Ever6 on the census of January 2018 plus £300 per child based on the 3 children of service personnel and £2,300 per child based on the 1 child who was previously looked after.
- January '19, we have 4 Children who are Looked After by the Local authority
