In English, we read a version of Shakespeare's play 'Julius Caesar'. We researched him in detail and have enjoyed thinking about the way Rome was ruled.

In Maths, we've begun a second unit on multiplication and division focussing more on written methods to solve calculations.

Parking






STARS OF THE WEEK
