<u>Learning this Week</u>

In our **English** work we have continued to focus on stories by Simon Bartram. The children have completed grammar assessments and have written their own adventures for Bob and Barry.

In **Mathematics** we have been looking at money, combining amounts and using the correct notations (£&p). Our **RE** work has focused on angels as messengers to Zechariah and the Annunciation.

In our **Science** we have sorted animals using their features and learned about the lifecycle of frogs.

<u>Learning next Week</u>

In our **RE** studies, we will be exploring the role Angels took in the Nativity of the Lord.

In **Mathematics** lessons we will be exploring time, the number of minutes and hours in the day, and sequencing intervals of time.

In our **English** and **Geography** work we will be exploring the features of non-chronological reports and begin researching information to write their own reports about penguins and polar bears.

In our **Science** work we will focus on researching other animal lifecycles, including butterflies and penguins.
