systems for our online technology however, the children are still monitored carefully by staff, when using the internet. We strongly recommend that you check your children's online activities daily and ensure you have strict parental controls set up on every digital device they can access. Please also be aware of online behaviours outside of the family home.

At Lea Endowed, we invest heavily in National Online Safety (National College), a "*Multi-Award-Winning platform in Online Safety Education for the Whole School Community.*" They provide online safety education, training, and updates for staff, parents and governors.
