Class 3 Newsletter – 10.5.19



This Week...

We are starting to get used to these four day weeks although it is very busy squeezing all our learning in to less days! The children have been looking at the structure of explanation texts in English and designing their own Bedroom Tidy Machines which they are going to write an explanation text for next week. We have focused on causal connectives and rhetorical questions at the beginning of a text to draw the reader in. In our Maths, we have started the tricky concept of decimals and been identifying the value of different digits before and after the decimal point. We also looked at time intervals using timelines which we will need to re-visit as the children found it quite tricky. We started our unit on forces in Science and enjoyed identifying forces in and around school. The children are now all able to identify key vocabulary relating to forces. In our RE, the children explored the book of Ruth and the impact it has on believers' lives today.
