## This Week

This week in **Maths**, we have explored negative numbers and Roman numerals. **Earthquakes:** San Francisco (1906), Turkmenistan (1948), Chile (1960), Japan (1995), Indonesia (2004) **Volcanoes:** Mount Vesuvius (<sup>AD</sup>79), Mount Unzen (<sup>AD</sup>1792), Krakatoa (<sup>AD</sup>1883), Mount St. Helens (<sup>AD</sup>1980), Eyjafjallajokull (<sup>AD</sup>2010)
