In Year 1...

We were so proud of all our Year 1 children for their fantastic Whole School Worship. Considering the short time we had to practise, all the children showed great courage and skill as the performed. They worked really well as a team to retell the story of Paul and share the message that God can be our rock.

This week we have been looking at money and trying to identify the value of coins and notes. If you have chance to look at some real coins and notes, that would be really useful for consolidating their learning. In English we have been working on out sentence formation and comprehension.

In Year 2 ...

In English we have been looking at the story The Owl who was Afraid of the Dark and have been working through each chapter. We have learnt lots of information about barn owls and other facts about constellations. We created our own fact files for Barn Owls and created our own part of the story.

In Maths we have been looking at how to present information and have been creating tally charts and pictograms. We voted on our favourite fruit and sports to help us with our learning.
