<u>Learning this Week</u>

Our **English** work this week has focused on past tense, different types of sentences and using the suffixes _ful & _less. We have written our own stories about Little Mouse using past tense.

In our **Mathematics** lessons we have focused on solving word problems using addition and subtraction. In our **Science** lesson we have explored micro-habitats and collected our own minibeasts to observe and study. **RE** work has focused on Easter traditions in Poland, Greece, Russia and Germany.

<u>Learning Next Week</u>

We will be focusing on information texts and persuasive texts in our **English** work and writing our own persuasive texts. We will also focus on the suffixes _est and _er Our **Mathematics** will focus on fractions. Finding fractions of shapes and quantities and exploring different ways fractions can be presented.

In **Science** we will be using data logging equipment to collect data about habitats and continue to collect, study and observe creatures in different micro-habitats. In our **RE** work we will finding out more about Easter traditions in Germany before exploring Easter traditions and customs in Mexico and Spain.
