We have been up to space this week. We are exploring 'How to catch a star' in Literacy, and have been learning about Neil Armstrong as part of our Significant Scientists topic in Science. In RE we have learned how Jesus met some of his special friends and that they are known as the Disciples. We learned how some were fishermen before they went to follow Jesus. In Maths we have looked at repeating patterns and tried to work out what the pattern rule is. We made our own patterns using a simple pattern rule.
