





LEARNING IN SCHOOL

English: Wow! We are loving the story of Beowulf. We are enjoying the incredible vocabulary used as well as the details of the fights with Grendel. We are building up now to our retelling of Beowulf's next conquest against the Sea-Hag.

Maths: We have spent the last two weeks focussing on fractions. We have found equivalents, converted between mixed numbers and improper fractions as well as adding and subtracting fractions.

RE: Continuing our unit on Lent, we have continued with thinking about Jesus' emotions using the 40 images. We have also identified how Lent is celebrated using a range of food.

Science: We focussed on investigating air resistance and water resistance. Lots of mess, paper airplanes, running with parachutes and wet blu-tac.

History: We have continued thinking about the Anglo Saxons. We have used maps to identify where the Anglo Saxons settled and have used clay to create items from everyday life.

DT: We designed and made prototypes of our moving models of Saxon warriors.
