This Week

In **English** this week, we have begun a new genre of writing: newspaper recounts. The context for our writing will be the recent Californian wild fires. We have focussed on generating a wide range of vocabulary suitable to fire, which we will then use throughout our unit. In **Maths**, we have been getting to grips with decimal numbers (the value of their digits, rounding them, ordering them).

In **RE**, we continued to look at the two Biblical accounts of the Christmas story and how they differ from each other but also the reason why they are different. In **Science**, we planned an investigation of our own to explore dissolving further. In **PE**, we continued to adapt, improve and add features to our gymnastics routine. In **Art**, we focussed using charcoal to create Egyptian friezes. In **History**, we explored how Ancient Egypt was ruled.

Stars of the Week


The CHRISTIAN VALUE award for PEACE goes to Libby for conducting herself in a peaceful manner in many subjects.
