

Drop off and Pickup

Children will be dropped off between 8:45am and 9:00am and go straight into their morning classrooms. Pick Up

Reminders

Reading

A named reading book bag **is** allowed but **no** rucksacks or large bags please. Thank you for returning any reading books you had at home.

Any books returned to school will be set aside for 3 days. We will endeavour to change books as often as required. Please spend at least 10 minutes, for a minimum of 5 times a week reading or sharing a book with your child.

Water Bottles

Children will need to bring a named water bottle every day to school to be returned home each day for washing.

Lunches

All packed lunches will need to be disposable (no lunch boxes). Those children having school dinners will be provided with a choice of hot lunches or sandwiches. All children will be eating lunch in their Bubbles.

Snacks

Children may bring in a named healthy snack for morning break e.g. fruit, cereal bar, yoghurt pouches, dried fruit boxes.

Learning in Year 1

English

We have been practising our handwriting and presentation skills. We have also been revisiting our letter sounds and trying our best to blend letters together to read. We will continue next week with poetry and rhyme, with the help of Harry the Mouse. The children have all worked really well to write lots in their books and recognise rhyming words.

Maths

The class have been working really well to write numbers 0 to 20 and recognise number names to 10. We have been doing lots of counting and counting in 10's. We will continue to identify and represent numbers using pictures. We will also use number lines to practise counting.
