

Extreme Weather Conditions and Unavoidable School Closures

Please be advised that during periods of adverse weather conditions eg snow or ice, the Site Supervisor (or other responsible person) will make every effort to clear the pavement immediately outside the front of school (on Sidgreaves Lane). The path leading from the main gate to the Main Entrance will also be cleared. Where possible the playground will be cleared of snow. During icy conditions, the playground, paths and pavement immediately outside school (on Sidgreaves Lane), will also be gritted.

POSSIBLE REASONS FOR UNAVOIDABLE SCHOOL CLOSURE

Premises Related Issues eg: Breakdown of major equipment (e.g. boiler) • Fire • Flood

Environmental Health Issues eg Epidemics

Emergencies eg Adverse/Extreme weather • Bomb alert • Police action • Emergency Planning

Personnel Issues eg Excessive Staff absence
