## Learning This Week

This week we have enjoyed exploring the story 'Katie Morag and the Big Boy Cousins' by Mairi Hedderwick. We have been looking at adjectives and identified and used them in sentences to add description to written sentences.

In our maths work we have been investigating place value using concrete materials to make and identify numbers to 50 and 100, partitioned numbers into tens and ones and found one more and one less than a given two-digit number.

In our RE activities we have been exploring special books and in our Science work, we have been investigating 'stinky' pots and identifying smells.

## Learning Next Week

Next week we will begin looking at the Bible as a holy book for Christians in our RE activities and will investigate our senses of taste and hearing.

In English we will be retelling, planning and writing our own stories and finding ten more and ten less for a given number, counting in tens and completing number sequences in our maths work.
