



## **LENT APPEAL 2022**

A huge thank you for all your generous donations of toys and books for our Toy Sale fund raiser for The Ukraine.

The Ethos Group and Extra Milers did a wonderful job of running the sale and thanks to a great joint effort, with Class 4, organising all the toys ready to sell, together we raised an amazing £653.65 to help support the British Red Cross and their tremendous work helping the people of The Ukraine.

The money we've raised can help with the following:

£10 could provide a hygiene kit to a family of five, giving them supplies to stay healthy for a month

£20 could provide five blankets to families taking shelter £30 could provide 3,600 chlorine tablets to ensure that families have access to clean, safe water

£100 could provide sleeping mats for 66 people who have been forced from their homes

£210 could provide a fully equipped first aid kit, including supplies, to a first aider treating those wounded. **Thank you!**
