This Week

Welcome back to the new half term. We have had a bumpy start to the half term. Some children have had very bubbly behaviour, particularly during afternoon lessons. In **English**, we have focussed on grammar - on using apostrophes for possession and punctuating speech accurately. In **Maths**, we have used a written method for multiplication. It is obvious the progress some children are making due to their hard work on Times Table Rock Star. They are actively applying their times tables knowledge which is fantastic to see. In **Science**, we started our unit of Animals (including humans) with a particular focus on the skeletal systems that animals have. In **Geography**, we used atlases and our mapping skills to identify how the UK is divided into countries and counties. In **PE**, we began our gymnastics unit focusing on partner balances. We also began our dance unit focussing on the Maori Haka. In **Computing**, we began our coding unit on creating a simple game.
