We identified the necessary features and then analysed a text that explained gravity. In **Maths**, our focus has been on time. We identified the time on analogue clocks as well as both 12-hour and 24-hour digital clocks. In **RE**, we listened to and enjoyed the songs 'Shine, Jesus Shine' and 'My Lighthouse' and explored how the lyrics of those songs tell us about Jesus and his light. In **Science**, we planned, set up and carried out a fair test investigating the push and pull nature of friction.In **PE**, we performed our robotic dance sequences using Black Sabbath's song 'Iron Man'. In **History**, we made models of Stone Age and Bronze Age homes.
