

Class Newsletter Autumn Term – 11/09/2020



This Week

This week the children have settled in to a good routine of learning. All the children have returned to school and have maintained the high level of handwriting, which was our focus earlier this year. In **English**, we have begun a unit using the Dick King-Smith novel 'The Water Horse'. We have focussed on using speech punctuation accurately, using pronouns effectively and using adjectives and noun phrases to describe the creature found in the egg. In **Maths**, we have been recapping our Place Value knowledge. We have identified the values of digits, applied our knowledge of powers of 10, and counted using a variety of intervals. In **RE**, we have started our unit that focuses on The Lord's Prayer. This week, we explored the language used in it and compared different versions, both in English and in other languages. In **Science**, we started our unit on States of Matter, defining each state using labelled diagrams. In **Geography**, we used atlases to identify significant rivers throughout the world.

In **Computing**, we focussed on staying safe online.

THE SCHOOL DAY

- > No adults on site without an appointment
- Start of the day from 8:45am to 9:00am
 - No children allowed to enter school premises until 8:45am

 - Wash hands

OTHER PRACTICALITIES

- PE Kits
 - PE day is WEDNESDAY
 - Only wear PE kit on our PE day all day
 - Plain navy blue hoodie / plain white tee shirt / plain navy blue joggers / plain black shorts
 - Appropriate black trainers
 - No branding or logos allowed
- Packed lunches
 - Disposable packed lunches only (must be able to throw <u>everything</u> away)
 - No reusable lunch boxes/Tupperware
 - Eat lunch in classroom
 - Still a choice of hot school lunches
- Water bottles
 - Named water bottle in school
 - Please wash every night and bring back to school, full
- Reading books
 - Only book bag to be brought into school
 - No rucksacks or large bags
 - Reading books will be quarantined before redistribution
 - Will not be changed as regularly due to current arrangements
- Stationery
