It has a long coastline on both the North Sea and Norwegian Sea.




A **fjord** is a deep, narrow inlet of water. It is surrounded by land on three sides.

Fjords are shaped by glaciers.

Fjord is an ancient Viking term that means 'where you travel across' (der man ferder over) and the word 'ferry' (ferje).





Norway has over 1000 fjords and they are all examples of how beautiful nature can be.

Glaciers are formed when layers of snow compact into ice over many years.




<u>The UK</u>
