Can you name and draw 5 things that you would take with you?</p> <p>Can you think of how you would stay fit and healthy on the desert island?</p>
<p>Can you design a sandcastle of your own? If you have some sand at home you could even try to build it.</p> <p>Can you find out about some sand sculptures that have been made on beaches around the world and choose your favourite one?</p>	<p>Find out about animals that you might find at the seaside. Can you draw them and label them?</p> <p>Can you pick one animal that you might find at the seaside and find out 5 facts about it?</p>	<p>Make your own ice lollies. Can you make them healthy and using different ingredients?</p> <p>Can you carry out a taste test and decide which ice lolly is the nicest that you have made? What ingredients did you put in it?</p>
<p>Find out about plants that can live in sand. Draw or make this plant.</p> <p>What makes them able to live in the sand and not soil?</p>	<p>Design your own model boat and build it. You could use lollypop sticks, twigs or junk model. Take a photograph of the boat you have created.</p> <p>Can you test your boat to see if it floats? If it sinks, what can you do to make it float?</p>	<p>Find out about rock pools that you can find at the seaside. What lives in them?.</p> <p>Can you make your own rockpool at home? You could use a clear plastic bowl to hold your water.</p>
