#### Learning this Week

This week we have begun our new topic for this half term - Minibeast Madness.

Our **English** work this week has focused on commas in lists and writing instructions for making our moon buggies. We have also focused on the stories 'Stickman' and 'Superworm' by Julia Donaldson.

In our **Mathematics** lessons we have focused on length and measures.

In our **Science** lessons we have explored things that are alive, dead and that have never lived and explored the habitats and environments in our school environment. Our **RE** work has focused on the stories of the deaf mute and the paralysed man. We have explored what these stories reveal about Jesus the man and how he shows friendship to others.

#### Learning Next Week

We will be focusing on past and present tense in our **English** work and writing narratives. We will also focus on the suffixes \_less and \_ful.

Our **Mathematics** will focus on Mass and addition and subtraction.

In **Science** we will be exploring animal habitats and how different animals are suited to their environments. In our **RE** work we will begin our new topic exploring Easter traditions in countries around the world and how different cultures celebrate. We will also begin exploring collage and the work of artist Henri Matisse in our **Art** lesson.
