## **<u>`Meet the Scientist' Homework Project</u>**

In Science, we are exploring the Solar System. There are various scientists linked with this unit. The children need to research a scientist of their choice. Once they have found out the information, they need to bring their findings into school.

## We will then 'hot seat' each scientist to find out information about them.

There are 'non-negotiable' information the children need to find and then a chance for the children to find out a little something extra if they wish.

  - This is the chance for the children to find out something that interests them about their chosen scientist
