#### **Physical Education – Games/Dance**

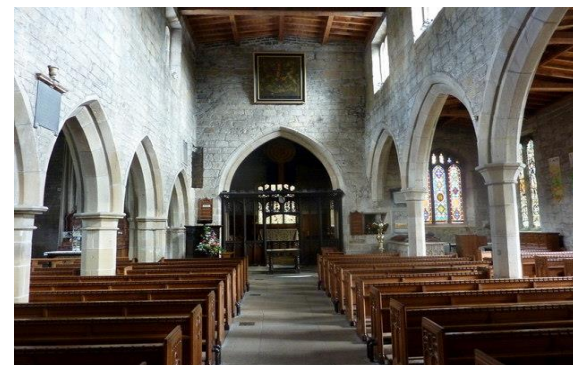
**Remember to try and be active for at least 60 minutes a day.**
