This Week...

The Year 6 children gave us a lot to think about during their service of Remembrance on Monday. The sacrifice made by so many was commemorated and the children behaved with great respect. This continued on Tuesday when many of us wore wacky socks or tights to celebrate our uniqueness. We talked about the effects of bullying and how to tackle bullies and bring about positive change. We worked collaboratively to make a beautiful banner with this year's Anti Bullying slogan – "Change Starts With Us". Our English unit on fables worked well with this theme too; we have been discussing morals and discussing different viewpoints. Our Maths work has continued with multiplication and learning new strategies to help us with multiplying larger numbers.

Next Week...

We shall be writing our own fable based on The Hare and the Tortoise. The children will be applying their knowledge of conjunctions and direct speech to make their writing more interesting. We will be practising our skills of division in Maths and learning new strategies for dividing larger numbers. Times Tables Rock Star is great practise for this as it develops the children's understanding of the relationship between multiplication and division. We shall be cooking on Tuesday – please see homework sheet – as part of our topic on Food Glorious Food. In our Geography work, the children will be investigating Ordnance Survey Maps, looking at symbols and grid references. We will be exploring the prophet Elijah in our RE and putting ourselves in his shoes as he stands against the prophets of Baal.
