The last fortnight in class...

English

We have continued reading our class novel and have focused on reading skills and finding evidence in the text. We have been thinking about the characters' feelings, thoughts and motives from their actions. children have also been writing continuations of the story including, action, dialogue and description.

Maths

In Maths we have finished our work on ratios and looked at how this can be applied in real life situations, such as following recipes. We have also started some Maths work on algebra and equations.

Across the Curriculum

The children have been thinking about 'freedom' in R.E. and what it means to be free. We have also been finding out about people who are 'freedom fighters'. In Science we have been studying invertebrates and vertebrates and their characteristics. Geography work has focused around the 2004 tsunami and the effects it had. In Art, the children have begun creating clay sculptures based on plants; these are coming along nicely!

Curriculum Award


