English



This week we are exploring the books of author Julia Donaldson.

Why not dig out some old favourites and enjoy re-reading them together!

- Collect words and phrases, discuss meanings of any unknown words and then ask your child to write some sentences to describe the character, using vocabulary from within the text. They may choose to re-write the lines in rhyme or simply write as a paragraph. Either is fine!
- Check spelling and punctuation in each sentence together. Do this with a different story each day. Remember to use your best handwriting!
- Find and learn words with the suffix **_ly**. eg. slowly, gently, quickly

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Other Subject Learning

Science – Plants

Explore plants in the garden.



Can you name all the parts of a plant? Does the plant grow from a seed or a bulb? Plant a bulb or a seed and observe what happens over the coming weeks. Keep a plant diary of any changes that occur. Photographs are good too!

Geography – Continents and Oceans

Do you know how many continents there are? Find out the names of the continents and the world oceans. Can you make a simple map of these?

Art/Craft – Sculpture (Ocean Animals)

What is sculpture? Research animals that live in the seas and oceans. Choose an animal and draw a labelled picture of your sea animal. Can you make a model of it using playdoh or salt dough? (Simple recipes for making your own can be easily found online) Take a picture of your creation and add it to your research.

Computing – Researching and Retrieval/Coding

Use a website safely to research animals and continents.

Use Espresso Coding to continue/complete activities in Year 2 Coding Unit 2a.

Physical Education – Games

Enjoy the great weather – play games throwing, striking and catching balls eg. "Piggy in the Middle", playing football, tennis or cricket in the garden.

Special Places

Ask your child to think of special places they enjoy.

- Why are they special? What do they do there? Why/when do they visit them? Who goes with them? Is anyone allowed to visit with them?
- How do they feel when they are sitting in their special place?
- Where is the friendliest place the children have ever visited?
- Where is the most amazing place/building they have ever visited? Have they ever visited a place that made them go 'Wow'? Can they think of the names of any places that are special for others?
- Together transform a corner into a special place/den. Take a photo.

Ask the question 'Why is the church a special place for Christians?'
