#### Learning this Week

In English we have mixed a little bit of learning about history with our English. Not only have we been perfecting our rhyming skills but also learning about the Great Fire of London through the poem written for kids by Paul Perro. We have learned new vocabulary and have sequenced the events that led to the Great Fire.

In Maths we have been ordering numbers from 0-100 and using a number line to place 2 digit numbers on the correct place. We have also been rounding numbers to the nearest 10 and nearest 100 and discussed how rounding numbers can be a useful skill for all sorts of reasons.

In **RE** we have talked about the way Jesus showed He was a good friend to others, and particularly to children, who he always welcomed.

In **Science** we enjoyed experimenting with a light source and an object. We were finding out what would happen to the size of the shadow as we moved the light nearer.

We will continue sequencing and learning about rhyming patterns through story. In Maths we will be exploring more about 2D and 3D shapes through recognising shape properties. In topic we will continue to be detectives uncovering the Gunpowder Plot looking at pictures and asking what the pictures prove us.
