In English we have started a new Class Novel: Deep Water by Ann Turnball. It is a fantastic story about friendship and making good choices. The children are really enjoying it. We have been skimming and scanning for key information, finding evidence in the text and writing diary entries.

In Maths we have been recapping multiples, factors and prime numbers and using this to help us with equivalent fractions. We have also been working out equivalent fractions, decimals and percentages.

As well as this, we have completed some Maths and English tests in order to help me see how the children are progressing and any areas in which they need additional support.

We have also shared our Remembrance Service with the whole school, been finding out about how World War One started, then creating some beautiful Remembrance day Art. In Science, we have started out topic on Electricity.
