### The last fortnight in class...

In English lessons we have been studying newspapers and their features. The children have written their own articles about the discovery of a brand new animals species (which they created in Science! In Maths we have been learning about multiples, factors and prime numbers and we have been exploring a range of strategies for multiplying numbers.

In Science, we have been studying adaptations in animals how they have changed to survive in their habitats. In Geography, we have been finding out about longitude and latitude and using this knowledge to locate places on our Earth. We have also talked about the ever-important subject of online safety; the children have been sharing their knowledge about how to stay safe online! We have created some beautiful 'harvest art' and the children have also painted and drawn silhouettes of animals. In R.E., we have been thinking about what a 'Super Christian' might be like and exploring how having a faith in God can influence our lives.
