This week, in **English**, we have continued thinking about Greek myths. We have focussed on exploring the Twelve tasks of Heracles. We have created Greek mythical creatures, written diaries and planned our own Greek myth. In **Maths**, we continued solidifying our addition and subtraction knowledge through tackling word problems and number problems. This really stretched us out of our comfort zone. In **RE**, we concluded our places of worship unit by investigating synagogues and Jews worship when they attend. In **Science**, we compared the early development of mammals, focussing on the growth of height and weight between humans, cows and dogs. In **PE**, we continued with our catching, throwing and striking skills before applying them in the context of rounders. In **History**, we investigated how it is we know so much about the Ancient Greeks – through architecture, sculpture and artefacts.
