This Week

We have started our new English unit which is going to centre around the text, The 101 Dalmations. We have learned a poem off by heart and have excelled at performing it as part of our work on improving Spoken Language. In Maths, we have been dealing with multiplication and division – the Year 4 children have been focusing on multiplying by 100 and dividing by 100 and seeing how this changes the number, using place value charts to recognise the pattern. The Year 3 children have been learning a written method for multiplying a 2 digit number by a single digit. We have also looked at the relative sizes and shapes of the Sun, Moon and Earth, researched the geographical origin of the Roman Empire and explored our Bibles to find evidence that Jesus is the Son of God.
