#### Learning this Week

This week in our **RE** studies, we have started our new topic, "Jesus, friend to everyone", and focused on the story of Jesus and the children.

In **Mathematics** lessons we have focused on finding ten more and ten less, rounding to the nearest ten and ordered masses.

In our **English** lessons we have been reading our class novel, collecting vocabulary and phrases and written character descriptions.

Our **History** work has focused on the Persian Explorer Ibn Battuta.

In our **Science** work we have continued looking at seasonal change, the season of Winter and how weather data can be collected.

#### Next Week

Our **English** work next week will continue focusing on our class novel and the children will be planning and writing their own adventures for Mr Penguin and Colin.

In our **Mathematics** lessons we will continue looking at measures, focusing on masses and solving problems using mass.
