Reading

I will recommend books that I have read to my peers, giving reasons for my choices.

In narratives, I will identify settings, characters and atmosphere and how the author integrates dialogue to convey character and advance the action. Use appropriate intonation, tone and volume to present their writing to a range of audiences.

Writing

I will discuss writing similar to that which I am planning to write, in order to understand and learn from its structure, vocabulary and grammar. Discuss and record ideas - using the present perfect form of verbs in contrast to the past tense · using and punctuating direct speech. Select appropriate grammar and vocabulary, understanding how such choices can change and enhance meaning. Identifying how language, structure, and presentation contribute to meaning. Generate and select from vocabulary banks.
