Light and Shadows

- •Recognise that light appears to travel in straight lines.
- •Use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain that objects are seen because they give out or reflect light into the eye.
- •Explain that we see things because the light that travels from light sources to our eyes or from light sources to objects and then to our eyes.
- •Use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them.
