# **BACK TO SCHOOL REMINDERS**

- In the morning there is **no adult** on the playground to supervise the children until **08:45am**. Children arriving before this time are parents' responsibility. As parking is an ongoing challenge, once the supervising adult is on the playground, we would politely request that you leave your child in their care and make space for other car users to drop off their children.
- All children need to have their full PE kit in school every day. (White t-shirt, black/blue shorts, black pumps, ankle socks)
- If using the Drop Off Zone in the morning on Lea Road, or parking directly outside school, please do NOT park on the yellow lines.
- Dinner Money must be sent in on a Friday morning (£2.30 per day, £11.50 per week).
- Toast is available to all children every day; 5p a day for half a slice in YR, Y1 and Y2 children (25p a week) and 10p a day
- **KS2 children (50p a week).** Toast money must be sent in on a Monday morning for the whole week.
- All money should be sent into the office in a clearly marked envelope with the child's name, amount enclosed, and the purpose of the money. There is a red box in the entrance porch, which can be used to safely deliver any money being sent into school. Envelopes and a pen available next to the post box
