This week we have been immersing ourselves in poetry - we really enjoyed performing The Sound Collector by Roger McGough. The adults in the classroom were so impressed that the children were able to learn the poem 'off by heart', and put actions to the words. We hope those parents who were able to come and watch us on Thursday enjoyed it too. The children used the poem to identify verbs and nouns and have created their own versions of the poem. In our Maths work, we have been revising 2D shape, identifying the properties of the shapes and calculating the perimeter of different quadrilaterals. Many children need to keep revising this work, so please help by identifying 2D shapes in the environment and using the vocabulary of sides, vertices, right angles, parallel sides, regular and irregular. We designed our own insulated cups in Science which we will test next week. The children chose their own materials and worked with a partner. Mrs Morris designed and made some recipes with the children on Thursday as part of our Design Technology topic and the children enjoyed trying some samples of French food in our Geography - thank you to those parents who contributed these items.
