The standard of our writing when we have written a paragraph a day has improved immensely. We then gave ourselves a break then wrote our own chapter independently, aiming to use all the grammar features. In **Maths**, our focus has been on dividing using written methods. In RE, we explored and investigated the two Biblical accounts of the Christmas story and sequenced the events that took place. The CHRISTIAN VALUE award for TRUST goes to Noemi who I can trust to give her best and show why she is an Extra Miler in all subjects.


The CURRICULUM award goes to Logan for making superb progress with his writing.
