The main thing the children need at this time is reassurance and calm...when you are ready, there is information on the Class 5 Area to support them in learning at home.

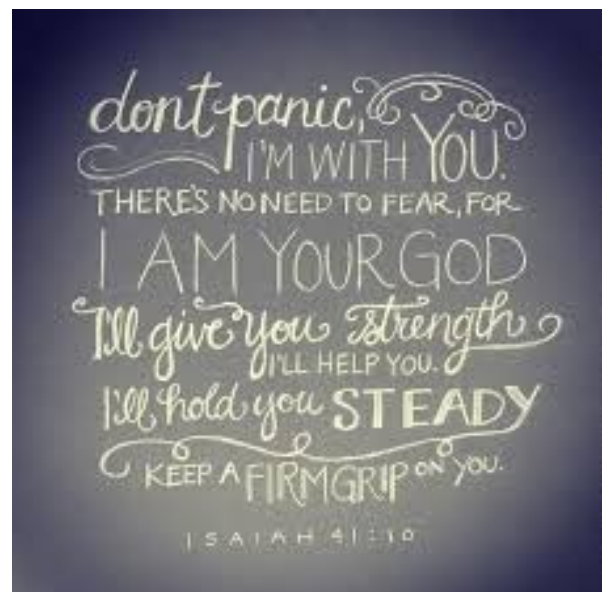
Please refer to the 'Continuation of Learning Plan' which is full of ideas for Learning that children can assess at home while school is closed.
