Reception

What a fantastic start to Reception we have had! The children are quickly settling into their new routines and getting to know the layout of the school and classroom. We are loving getting to know our Year 6 Buddies; they are looking after us so well and teaching us new games to play in the playground. In RE we are thinking how God has made us all UNIQUE and special. We have painted a self-portrait to show how we are different both on the outside and within. We are learning about the story of the Three Little Pigs and have enjoyed building strong brick houses. We have started learning Phonics already. Have a look in our Phonics Book to see what we know.

Year 1

We have had a lovely start to the Half Term with everyone in Year 1 ready and enthusiastic to continue their learning. The children loved reading 'The Runaway Pea' and writing simple sentences about the story. This week we have moved onto using our sound mats to spell words. You should have a copy of the sound mat attached to the Year 1 Meet the Teacher notes. Feel free to use the mat if your child would like to write at home too. In Maths we have been looking at 1 more and 1 less. Some of the children have already "wowed" me with their counting in 10s and I have set the class the challenge this week of learning this at home. Homework should have come home on Thursday to be returned on a Monday. You only need to complete **one** of the tasks each week if possible.
