

## Parent Information – Class 3 September 2020

### **Welcome and Introductions**

In Class 3 we have MISS Morris (Class Teacher) and MRS Morris (Higher Level Teaching Assistant). We are also supported in Class 3 by Mrs Emptage each morning and some afternoons.

Miss Morris will teach all the core subjects Maths, English, Science and R.E, as well as History and Geography etc. P.E. and French will be taught on a Monday afternoon by Mrs Morris. Mrs Morris will also teach Art and Computing on a Thursday afternoon.

### **Classroom Rules**

Our rules have been decided and agreed upon as a class. They are:

1. Listen carefully and look at the person who is talking.
2. Always try your hardest with your work.
3. Follow instructions carefully.
4. Always to be kind to each other.
5. Use good manners and be polite.
6. Be sensible and helpful.
7. Treat others how you want to be treated.
8. Be unique and shine in your own special way!

We use positive reinforcement, team points, stickers and certificates to reward the children for good behaviour.

### **Water**

Please send water to school each day in a named bottle. From 14<sup>th</sup> September, bottles will be sent home each night so they can be washed thoroughly with hot soapy water.

### **P.E kit and Uniform**

Please ensure your child's name is written clearly in **all** P.E. kits and uniform. P.E. lessons will be on a MONDAY. The children may come to school in their P.E. kit on this day (plain white t-shirt, plain black or navy joggers (no logo please), black or navy blue, plain hoodie and suitable plain trainers).

## **Routines and Homework**

### **Reading**

It is very important that children read at least 5 times a week for at least ten minutes a day. If you can manage every day, even better! Please sign your child's Reading Record each time they read at home. We will aim to change books at least twice a week. The reading records are new this year and contain a 'reading task' each week – these may be completed in school. However, if they are not, then the children can complete them at home as an extra homework task. Thank you for your support with the children's reading.

### **Multiplication tables**

Please practise these regularly at home as they have a huge impact on Maths work we do in school. The children all have a TIMES TABLES ROCKSTARS account which can be accessed from home. Their log-in details have been sent home on a separate letter. Please contact me if you don't know your child's log-in details.

### **Weekly Homework**

The children will be expected to practise times tables and spellings at home, as well as daily reading. Homework will be sent home at the start of each half term and should be handed in each Tuesday. The children will receive a 'Homework Choices' sheet for the half term. They will be asked to complete ONE activity each week in their homework book (please tick and date the choices sheet which will be stuck into their homework books). Homework will start next week.
