In Class 4 our theme is 'Planet Earth' and in Geography we are studying earthquakes and volcanoes. Your homework project is to create a PowerPoint Presentation, exploring one natural phenomenon in depth. You can use websites, library books and other sources to help you! It should ALL be your own work! (Do not copy and paste!) Each week there is a new task for you to complete to help manage your workload.

The project should be handed in on Monday 11th February.

We will then watch the presentations throughout the duration of that week.

There will be 1st, 2nd and 3rd place prizes as well as some projects being marked highly commended. Projects will be judged on effort, presentation, content and consistency.

You can choose to research one of the following **earthquakes** or **volcanoes**: **Earthquakes:** San Francisco (1906), Turkmenistan (1948), Chile (1960), Japan (1995), Indonesia (2004)

Volcanoes: Mount Vesuvius (^{AD}79), Mount Unzen (^{AD}1792), Krakatoa (^{AD}1883), Mount St. Helens (^{AD}1980), Eyjafjallajokull (^{AD}2010)

Week One (w/b 7th January)

Choose one of the earthquakes and volcanoes from lists above. Create your title slide.

Begin to research the facts around your natural disaster. where in the world, when did it happen, how many people suffered, what happened as a result etc....

Week Two (w/b 14th January)

Continue your research. Update your PowerPoint with new information you find. Create some slides giving the details about your natural disaster.

Week Three (w/b 21st January)

Continue your research. Update your PowerPoint with new information you find. Insert some suitable images related to your natural disaster.

Week Four (w/b 28th January)

Continue your research. Update your PowerPoint with new information you find.

Format your Power Point. Make it look how you want.

Week Five (w/b 4th February)

Add the finishing touches to your PowerPoint. Watch it through to make sure it plays how you want.

Save your presentation onto a USB stick to bring into school to show everybody (make sure it is labelled with your name!)
