- Check spelling and punctuation in each sentence together. Remember to use your best handwriting!
- Find, collect and learn words with the suffixes **_ness** and **_er**. How do the words change when you add these letters? Can you spot any patterns?

Other Subject Learning

Science – Plants



Keep up with your plant diary, recording any changes that occur to the plant you are growing. Remember to take photos of these changes too.

What does your plant need to stay alive and grow?

Geography – Continents and Oceans

Can you find out 5 interesting facts about the continent of America? What types of habitats/landscape features can you find out about? eg. The Rockies (mountains)

Art/Craft – Sculpture (Ocean Animals) Can you make a jellyfish, fish or shark using a recycled plastic bottle or other materials from your recycling bin?

Computing – Researching and Retrieval/Coding

Use a child friendly search engine to research American landmarks.
Espresso Coding - complete remaining activities in Year 2 Coding Unit 2a.

Physical Education – Games/Dance

Remember to try and be active for at least 60 minutes a day.

Riding a bike, playing on a scooter, skipping or bouncing on a trampoline are all good ways to get your heart rate up. Why not try dancing along with Boogie Beebies or dance to your favourite song? Challenge members of your family to learn a new dance!

RE – What is a Church?



Special Places

Ask the question 'Why is the church a special place for Christians?'
Mention briefly that there are other places of worship special to people of different faiths. Show pictures, refer to places locally. Do you have a special place of worship?

- Read or watch the story of Moses and the Tabernacle (Tent of meeting). Exodus 26

There are Children's Daily Bible Stories to be found on YouTube but, as with all internet based materials, please view any story you use before sharing with your child to check it is age appropriate and safe to view.

- Use or make a small tent. Write a prayer asking God to help others.
- In the tabernacle lamps are lit and kept burning as a symbol of the presence of God. Why does the lamp remind people of the presence of God?
- Take a photograph, or draw or paint a picture of your special tent.
