This Week

In **English** this week, we focussed grammatically on fronted adverbials and complex sentences that begin with 'ed' openers. We then wrote a whole new chapter of the Magic Faraway Tree and edited it to improve it further. In **Maths**, we have applied our addition and subtraction skills in the sphere of statistics. We have explored pictograms, bar graphs as well as line graphs. In **RE**, we explored the development and publication of the first Jamaican translation of the Bible (Jiizus buk) into Patois. It was fascinating to see people read about Jesus in their mother tongue for the first time. In **Science**, we continued to deepen our understanding of thermal conductors and insulators in the first of several investigations relating to insulating cups that hold drinks. In **PE**, we further developed our racquet skills and catching of a small ball in game situations. The Year 5's also went swimming.
