#### Attendance and Being on Time

We are very proud of our attendance at Lea Endowed, which has improved significantly over the last 3 years. Please be aware that you must **NOT** take your child out of school for a holiday in term time. It is vital that your child attends school regularly and is **on time** every day. If your child is absent for any reason you **MUST** contact school straight away to explain why your child will be absent. This can be done via telephone, or email. Morning registration is between 8.55 am and 9.00 am. This is the time your child must be in the classroom, so you need to ensure your child is coming through the school gate by 8.50am. There is always a member of staff on duty in the playground and at our 'Drop Off' area every morning from 8.45am. Children arriving between 9.00 am and 9.05am will be marked as late. Late arrivals are disruptive to the whole class and unsettling for your child.

Please note that arrival after the close of registration at 9.05am may be marked as an **unauthorised absence** in line with the DCFS guidance. Thank you for your cooperation in this very important matter.

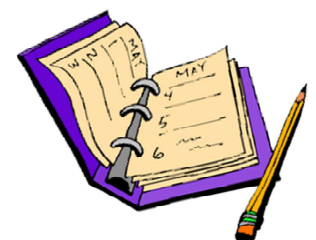
