Next Week...

Maths

We will be looking at place value, rounding and negative numbers. We will be ordering and comparing numbers including large numbers and decimals.

English

In English we will be continuing to read Deep Water and focusing on the language used and the characters' actions.

Homework and Reading

As the children are now in Year 6 they will be given a HOMEWORK DIARY AND READING RECORD—this is a record of your child's learning at home as well as a useful communication tool between home and school. Please could you look at your child's diary each week, add a comment if you wish and sign to say you have seen it. I will check the diaries on a Monday. Thank you—your support is greatly appreciated.

Homework in Class 5 will start next week. It will be handed out on a Thursday and returned to school on a Monday please. The children will receive one piece of Maths and one piece of English each week. Additionally the children will receive a project to complete at home that will last for the whole half term.

Reading books will also be given out next week. I am happy for them to read books from the school scheme alongside books of their own choice. Please encourage them to read for at least 15 minutes per day and record this in their Diaries. I will collect and check Diaries on a Friday.
