



## COVID CATCH UP PREMIUM

The COVID catch-up premium is based on £80/pupil with numbers taken from last year's census. Lea Endowed has been allocated £11,200.

1<sup>st</sup> payment of £2,800 received 20.10.20 with a balance: £8,400.

- 1 to 1 and small group support/tuition for targeted children
