This week we were very excited to see our friends again after our lovely half term break. We have started our new theme 'At the Seaside'. We have been learning our doubles in Maths and have learned that double 1 is the same as 1 +1. We are beginning to have instant recall of doubles to 10. In RE we are thinking about prayer. We looked at the different ways we send messages to people, and talked about how our prayers send a message to God.
