## **English**



## Reading

I will recognise digraphs in longer and compound words, and blend the sounds together.

I will read longer sentences, using my phonic and tricky word knowledge.

I will be able to answer questions about what I have read.

#### Writing

I will form letters correctly using a tripod pencil grip. I will learn how to spell and write more complex words and short phrases using the phonemes known. I will write with greater independence.

## **Spoken Language**

I will have conversations with adults and my friends with back-and-forth exchanges.

I will talk in sentences using a range of tenses.

**Phonics** (no new sounds or tricky words this half term)

I will read words with long vowel sounds.

I will read longer words by 'chunking'.

I will read words ending in: -s. -es, -ing, -ed.

I will consolidate my recognition of all the tricky words learned in Reception.

## **History**

I will learn what school was like for children in the past, including my parents and grandparents.
I will use simple vocabulary to describe passing time.
I will learn about the history of our school.
