Hello Parents,

Welcome back and we hope you have had a restful and joyful half term holiday.

This half term our theme for learning is Minibeast Madness! We will be investigating and learning about minibeasts and their micro-habitats in our science work and enjoying lots of minibeast themed stories in our English activities and work.

Learning This Week

This week in our English activities we have enjoyed sharing the story 'The Very Greedy Bee' by Steve Smallman, made our own bee models and have written instructions for Class 1 to make their own models.

In our maths work we have been focusing on division as grouping and sharing, using sorting hoops and counters to solve simple division calculations and use the basic notation for recording division calculations.

Learning Next Week

We will be looking at the stories 'Superworm' and 'The Snail and the Whale' by Julia Donaldson and planning and writing their own stories. In Maths we will continue practising division as grouping and compare and order measurements – lengths, heights and masses.

In Science we will explore and compare the differences between things that are living, dead and have never lived and identify habitats which provide basic needs for animals and plants. Our RE work will focus on spring and new life symbols.

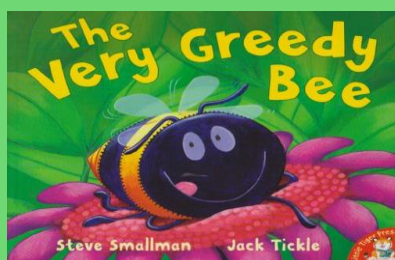
